Hosted by Largs Sailing Club the Scottish Sailing Institute**

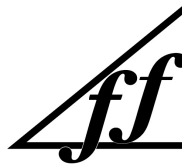


Sailing

Off the Water at Largs

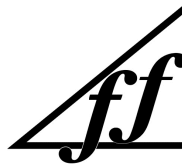
Family and friends planning to visit Largs can enjoy various attractions. These include the Paddle Steamer Waverley, which sails the Clyde and the Kyles of Bute to Tighnabruaich and also to Tarbert, Brodick or Rothesay and Dunoon.

Calmac run frequent ferries from Largs to Millport, the cycling and country and western festival island. Tourism, sailing, watersports, fishing and farming are main industries, along with IBM and Hunterston. Commuters travel to Glasgow and beyond, and expatriates working and living abroad are regular visitors back at Largs. There are two golf courses, putting, bowls, play parks, fishing, diving, a swimming pool, football parks and a great ten pin bowling alley. Popular with tourists and locals is the Vikingar, and Kelburn Country Centre and Castle which is just outside Largs.
